## Memorandum on Student Exchange between Faculty of Medicine, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan and Faculty of Medicine Universidad Austral de Chile

In accordance with clause 2 b), Exchange of students, of the Agreement on Academic Exchange concluded between Faculty of Medicine, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan and Faculty of Medicine, Universidad Austral de Chile, the two collaborating universities agree on the details of student exchange as follows:

- 1. The sending university will decide which students should be sent to the partner university, with due consideration given to the receiving university.
- 2. The status of visiting students at the receiving university will not be that of regular students. Furthermore, it is agreed and understood that the receiving university will not be compelled to award any degrees to visiting students.
- 3. All costs involved under this Memorandum (except items covered by clause 4, below) will be borne by each student or the sending university, although scholarships may be obtained independently from other institutions.
- 4. The receiving university will waive all charges for tuition and for any procedures involved in processing a visiting student's application.
- 5. Each university can send up to 2 students per year to the partner university, and the students so sent will be eligible to study for a maximum period of 6 months at the receiving university.
- 6. When visiting students under this Memorandum are ready to return to the sending university, or soon thereafter, the receiving university shall provide the sending university with information on the academic performance of each of the sending university's students who visited the receiving university. The sending university may duly recognize the credits earned by its students at the receiving university in accordance with its own regulations.
- 7. Each university will, to the extent possible, assist students sent to it under this Memorandum in securing accommodations and achieving their study and research goals.
- 8. Exchange students will secure health and accident insurance before traveling to the receiving university, and will carry proof of such insurance with them at all times.
- 9. This Memorandum will be in effect during the academic year 2013-2014 and will be valid for 5 years, i.e. through the academic year 2018-2019. This Memorandum shall be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both universities.
- 10. This Memorandum may be terminated by either university at any time by providing the

other university with 6 months notice (in writing) of the intention to terminate.

- 11. Matters not covered by this Memorandum shall be discussed by the two universities in consideration of the Agreement on Academic Exchange between Faculty of Medicine, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU), Japan and Faculty of Medicine, Universidad Austral de Chile.
- 12. This Memorandum is made in English in two copies, one for each party.
